Traditional Scottish

Pronunciation

a' ~ 'all' without final consonants (IPA: ɔː)
 bairn ~ rhymes with 'cairn' (with frontal rolled 'r') (IPA: bærn)
 owre ~ 'hour' (IPA: ʌr)
 thegither ~ the gither (hard 'g', hard 'th') to rhyme with 'the zither'

(IPA: International Phonetic Alphabet)
